Your guide and tour leader will meet you in the port of Giurgiu and drive you to Brasov, the gateway to Transylvania.

On your way to Brasov you'll first stop at Snagov Monastery, a medieval Orthodox Monastery built in Byzantine style during the late 14th century. Located on an island on Lake Snagov, this is the place where the infamous prince Vlad the Impaler

(known as Dracula) is supposed to have been buried.

Next you will stop at Peles Castle - the former summer residence of the royal family. Built by King Carol I in the late 1800s in German neo-classic style, this Disney-like palace is also one of the largest art galleries in Eastern Europe with absolutely mind-blowing interior decorations. Before visiting the castle, you will stop for included lunch.

Sighisoara, Biertan and Viscri Private Day Trip

Enjoy a magical day trip to Sighisoara, one of Europe's most beautiful and best-preserved medieval towns. With its towers, cobblestone streets, plentiful art, and old traditions, this town is a great way to enjoy a medieval atmosphere, and learn about the lives and history of the Transylvanian Saxons, German settlers who founded most of Transylvania's cities and towns.

After you visit Sighisoara with your private guide, you will continue with a visit of 2 of the most famous fortified churches in Transylvania: Biertan and Viscri.

Biertan's fortified church is easily one of the most beautiful Transylvanian Saxon structures, with its three rings of fortifications (and nine gate towers and bastions) ringing a tall Gothic church, overlooking the eponymous village.

Viscri is home both to a UNESCO-listed fortified church, and a guesthouse owned and restored by Prince Charles. Although the church was founded by Hungarians in 1100, it was fortified by German settlers, making it Transylvania's oldest fortified church..

Brasov and Bran Castle Private Walking Tour

Enjoy a guided walking tour in Brasov while learning some general facts about the town itself and the Transylvania region. Start from Council Square, visit the Black Church, the largest Lutheran church in Southeastern Europe and then continue down on the narrowest street in Europe, called Rope Street.

Next, there's just a 30 minute drive to the famous Bra Castle – a place where the legend of Vlad Impaler meets the fiction of count Dracula. After the tour you're headed to the capital, Bucharest. Your private guide will pick you up from your accommodation in the morning. You will stop at Azuga Rhein Cellars for a winery tour and tasting. The winery dates back to 1892. You will sample some incredible sparkling wines at the only place where Romaniansparkling wine has been produced continuously using the traditional method. You can also enjoy a delicious lunch for an extra fee (optional).

For your first night, it's best to start with a short walk in the Old Town to see a glimpse of how Bucharest looked and felt at its zenith. Seek out a traditional dinner at one of the city's famous restaurants:

Manuc Inn, Hanul Berarilor, or Caru cu Bere. Make sure you don't miss the bean soup in a bread bowl, cabbage rolls, or pork stew. Save some room for dessert:

the best option is Papanasi, a pastry shaped like a doughnut with a small sphere on top, filled with soft cheese, and covered in sour cream and sour jam.

After dinner, you should definitely enjoy a glass of Romanian wine at one of the many rooftop bars located in the Old Town: Linea Closer to the Moon, Nomad SkyBar, or Pura Vida SkyBar. You're in a Latin country so get out there and enjoy the vibe!

Get to Know Bucharest on a Private Walking Tour

Today you get your bearings in Bucharest on a private tour with a local guide. On this 5 hour tour you'll take in all the major sights, the Romanian Atheneum – city's symbol and the most famous concert hall, Revolution Square - where the 1989 anti-Communist revolt went nationwide, Museum of National Contemporary Art, former Royal Palace, Old City and Old Court of Vlad the Impaler (Dracula legend inspiration) – includes Manuc's Inn and Stavropoleos Church and the massive Palace of Parliament (famously known as Ceausescu's Palace or People's Palace, conceived by Romania's last dictator, Nicolae Ceausescu). It's all impressive, to say the least. Bring your passport, which you'll need to enter the Parliament building. After the tour you will have some free time for lunch and shopping before the farewell dinner..
